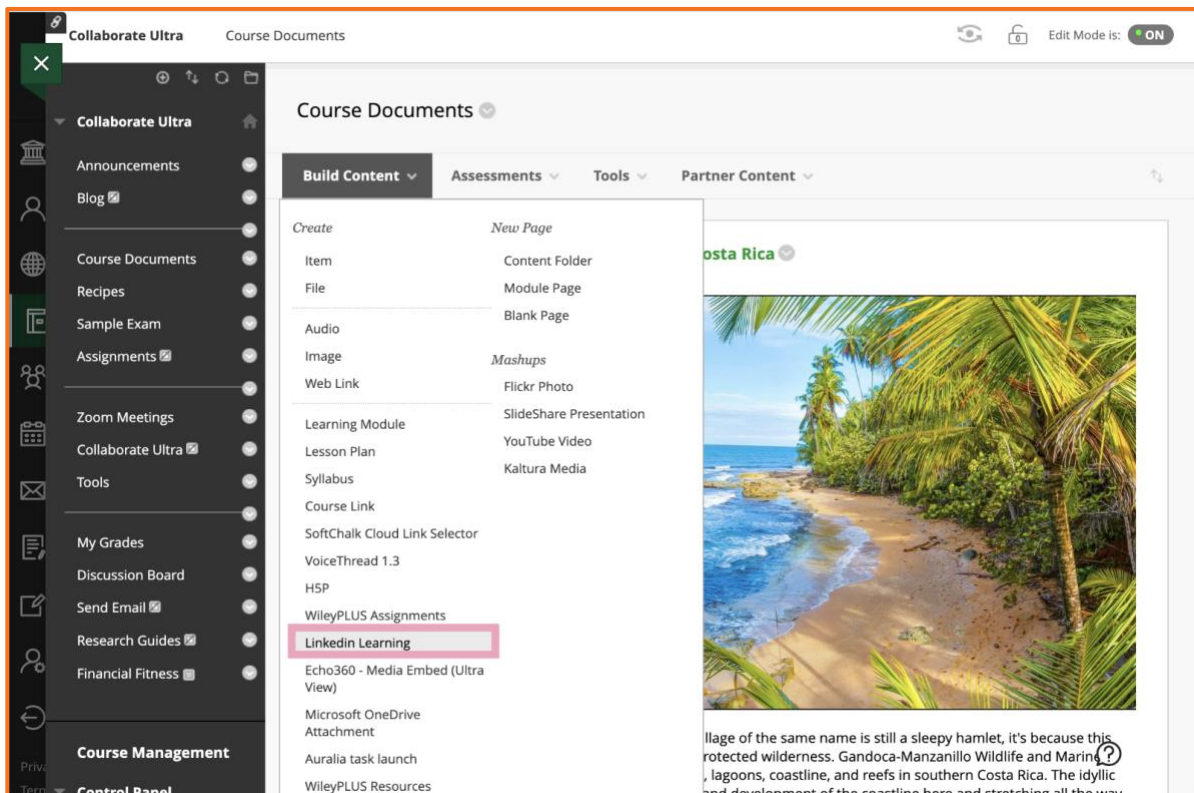

Launch LinkedIn Learning in Your Course

- Once you are logged in to Blackboard (courses.miami.edu), select **Courses** from the Ultra Base Navigation menu and click on the course you would like to open and add content to.

Blackboard Original Course View

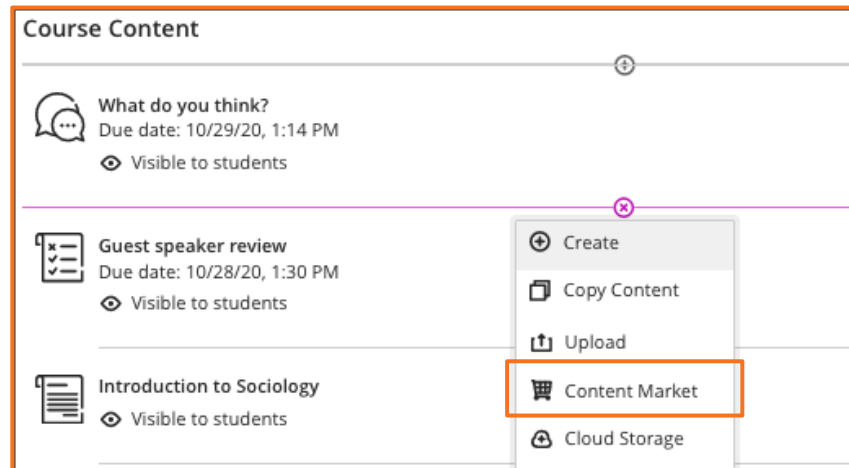
- Enter a section of the course, such as **Course Documents** or **Assignments** on the left-hand menu panel.
- Select **Build Content** by hovering the mouse over but not clicking the mouse. **LinkedIn Learning** will appear left click the tool.



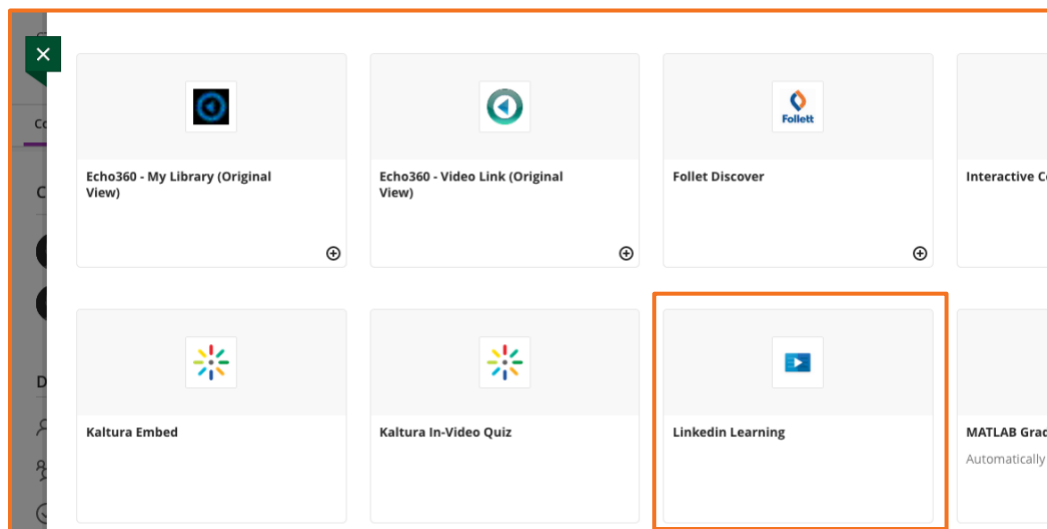
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Blackboard Ultra Course View

1. Select the **Add Content** tool, a purple circle with the (+) on the top right-hand side. Select **Content Market** by left clicking it.



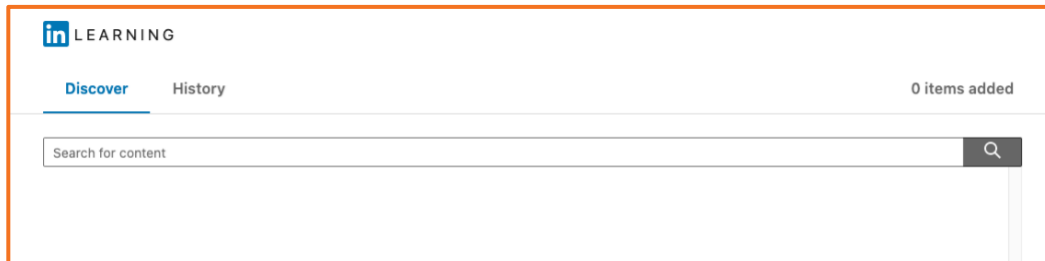
2. Scroll down until you find the link for **LinkedIn Learning**.



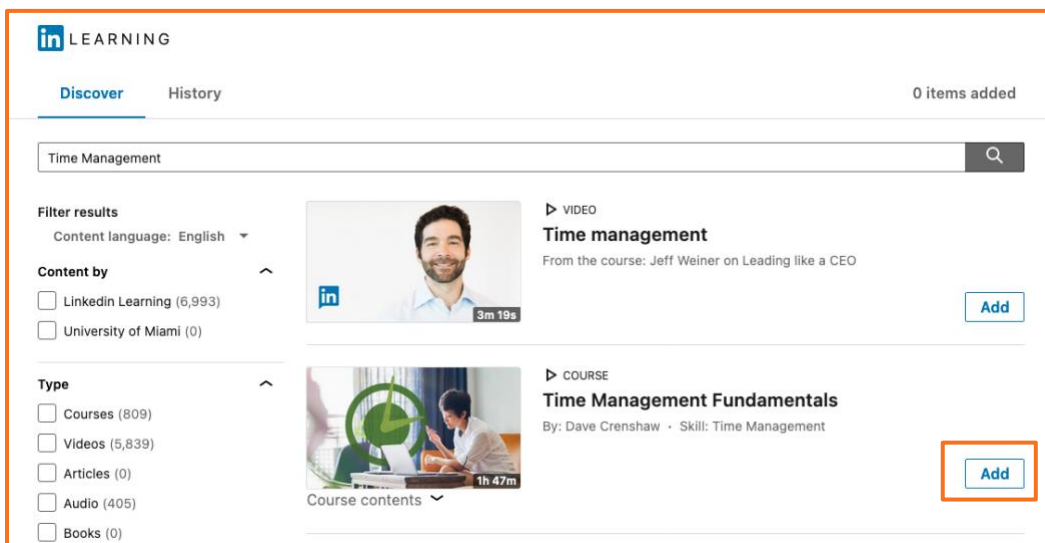
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Search And Add LinkedIn Learning Content To Your Course

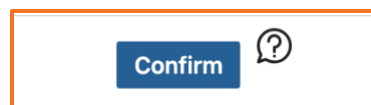
1. Search for content in the search bar. Type one or two words at a time for best results.



2. Browse and preview the videos that are of interest. Once the video has been selected, click **Add** on the right-hand side. Click **Remove** to remove the video before confirming.



3. On the lower right-hand side of the screen, select **Confirm** to add to your course. Multiple videos may be added before confirming.



4. The LinkedIn Learning content will be added your course as an assignment.

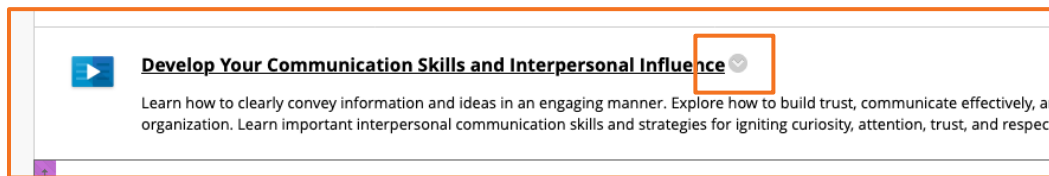
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Edit Assignment Settings

By default, all LinkedIn Learning content is added as a graded assignment. You can change the points possible, or other assignment settings.

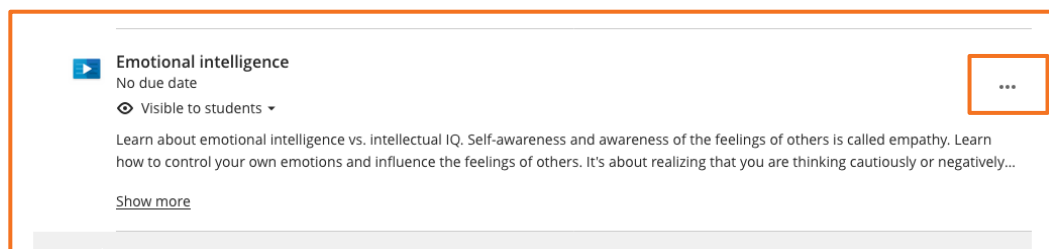
Blackboard Original Course View

1. Click on the drop-down arrow to edit the settings. Here, you can update due date, points possible, among [other assignment settings](#).

2. Click on [...] icon and click **Edit** to access the settings. Here, you can update due date, points possible, among [other assignment settings](#).
