Creating Assignments in Turnitin

Turnitin assignments are typically created through your Learning Management System (e.g., Canvas) and allow you to enable similarity checking, feedback tools, and grading features within Turnitin Feedback Studio.

How to Create an Assignment on Turnitin

1. Once you've opened Turnitin, click **Create Assignment** to begin.
2. You will be prompted to **enter**:
 - a. The assignment title
 - b. The assignment instructions
 - c. The availability dates, due date, and when feedback will be released to students
 - d. The total number of points for the assignment

3. Under Assignment Details, you can also upload a **template** and edit the **submission settings**
 - a. Template is to:
 - i. Upload a document of what the students' assignments should look like
 - b. Submission Settings is where you:
 - i. Allow **late submissions**
 - ii. Allow **resubmissions**
 - iii. Allow **unsupported file types**
