



Turnitin provides access to the Similarity Report and other submission insights directly within Feedback Studio.

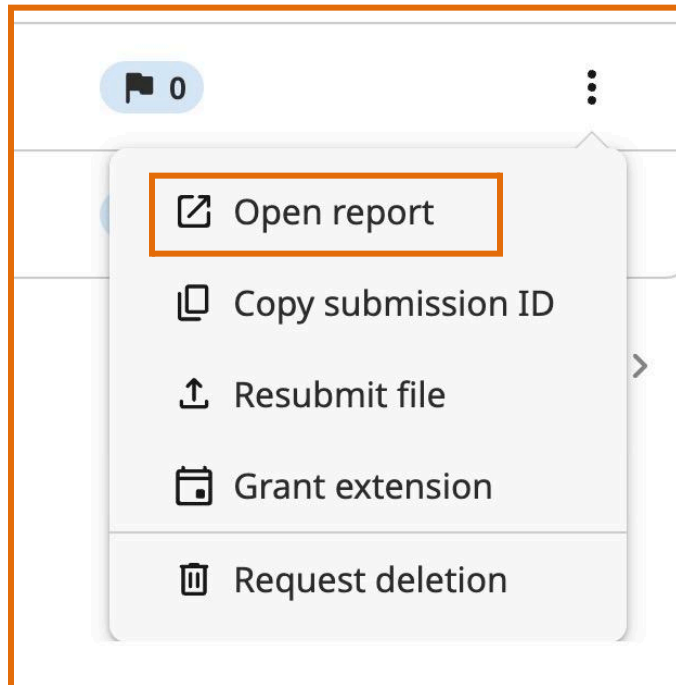
Accessing Reports

1. Open your course in Canvas
2. Navigate to **Assignments** and select the Turnitin-enabled assignment
3. Select the three dots besides a student's name.

Accessing Reports

5. Here is where you can view:
 - a. The Similarity report
 - i. The Similarity Report compares a student's submission against Turnitin's database (including other student papers, websites, and publications) to highlight matching or similar text.
 - b. Flags
 - i. Flags alert instructors to potential issues within a submission, such as unusual similarities, hidden text, or other integrity concerns.
 - c. Feedback
 - i. The Feedback section allows instructors to leave inline comments, overall comments, and QuickMarks directly on the student's submission.
 - d. Rubrics
 - i. Rubrics enable instructors to assess assignments using predefined criteria and scoring levels for consistent and transparent grading.
