

Accessing Alternative Formats with YuJa Panorama

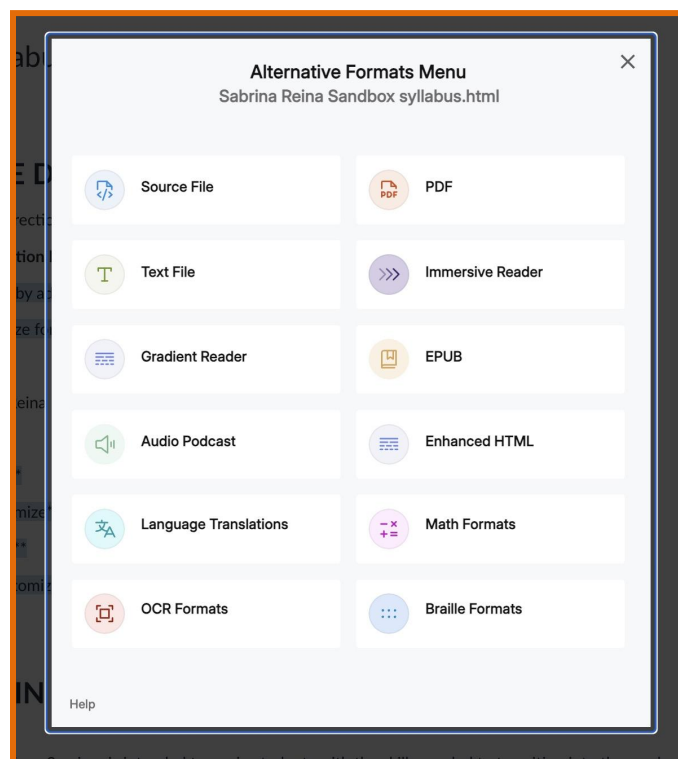
YuJa Panorama allows students to access course materials in alternative formats directly within Canvas. Alternative formats provide different ways to read, listen to, or interact with course content.

Accessing Alternative Formats

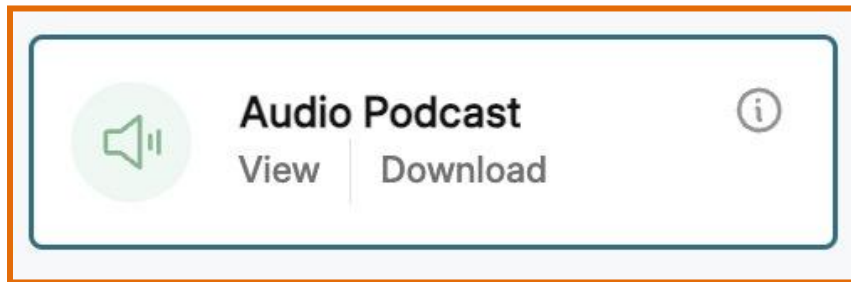
1. Open your course in Canvas
2. Navigate to the course content or file you would like to access.
3. Select the **Alternative Formats** icon next to the document.



4. The **Alternative Formats** window will open. Select the format you would like to use.



5. Select **Generate** to create the alternative version of the document.
6. Once the file has finished processing, access the generated alternative format.



Available Alternative Formats

Depending on the document, available formats may include:

a. Text

- i. Provides the document content in a simplified text-based format.

b. EPUB

- i. Provides a format designed for reading on e-readers and other compatible devices.

c. Audio

- i. Converts supported text into an audio format for listening.

d. Braille

- i. Provides a version compatible with supported braille technologies.

e. Immersive Reader

- i. Provides additional reading and display tools to make content easier to interact with.

f. Enhanced HTML

- i. Provides an accessible, browser-based version of the document.

g. Translated Version

- i. Provides supported document content in another available language.
